I have taught in inner-city schools, farm communities, the diverse Beacon Hill neighborhood of Seattle, and directed other education programs in four states. I worked with communities to establish early education programs, as a tool for prevention of child abuse and neglect, academic success and kindergarten readiness. I have taught at Peninsula College and Anchorage Community College. In Port Angeles, I have worked with the homeless population establishing the family shelter-housing program of Serenity House.

For 22 years, I was the director of Lutheran Community Services NW—Parent Line working with low-income families, child care providers, Navy personnel with children with special needs and residents of Mt. Angeles View. I worked with Judge Ken Williams and others to help establish the first Juvenile Drug Court in the state of Washington. My staff and I provided Family Support Services to both the Juvenile and Adult Drug Courts of Clallam County.

Now, I serve on several boards and commissions: Clallam County Mental Health and Chemical Dependency Advisory Board (Hargrove Funds), Homeward Bound (affordable housing) Sequim Cares (homeless), Child Check (social, emotional and behavioral screening for young children).

I am a member of the Sierra Club, Audubon, ACLU and have volunteered with Red Cross as a disaster case manager.

I worked on both Mark Ozias’ campaign and Ron Richards’ campaign for Clallam County Commissioner. I also am a PCO in District 3 and volunteer at Headquarters 1 day a week.

The common good and dignity of all people is the common thread which ties all Democrats together.
