Likewise, I was briefly the Event Coordinator for the Olympic Peninsula Healthy Communities Coalition before COVID put a stop to in-person gatherings.

During this legislative session, I will be doing a fellowship with Fair Vote Washington to help advance ranked-choice voting. To support my organizing passions, I have worked service jobs at Oak Table Café and Bella Italia, with ambitions to have a full-time career in policy. My top issues are reproductive justice, a living wage, protecting the environment, affordable housing, robust public transit systems, and respecting Native treaties.
