

HOW TO ATTEND AND VOTE AT THE 2020 BIENNIAL CLALLAM COUNTY DEMOCRATS' REORGANIZATION MEETING

Here are important things to know to prepare for the Clallam County Democrats' Reorganization meeting to be held via Zoom on **Saturday, December 19, 2020 at 2 PM.**

1. GET YOUR VOTER CODE:

CCD members who fill out and submit a [Voter Code Form](#) by 5 PM on Wednesday, December 16, 2020 will receive a unique 3-letter Voter Code via email from CCDreorg2020@gmail.com. (***Be sure to check your spam and junk folders for this important message!***) The Voter Code will arrive approximately 48 hours prior to the meeting being called to order. Members who share an email address will need to fill out and submit separate Voter Code Forms and will receive separate unique codes. Only one vote per Voter Code will be counted, so make sure to use the code that was assigned to you and you alone.

You can fill out the [Voter Code Form](#) now if you like. It will also be emailed to all CCD members who have provided an email address.

2. ZOOM LINK TO ATTEND MEETING:

On meeting day -- Saturday, December 19th at 2 PM -- participants will need to log in to Zoom via a link or phone number(s) that will be announced later in a separate email, newsletter, and on the [Clallam County Democrats website](#).

3. BALLOT LINKS AND VOTING PROCESS:

Once the meeting is called to order, a series of ballot links will be sent to the email address you provided in your Voter Code Form or the Chair will send them to you via Zoom Chat. These links can be used by people who are logged into Zoom through smart phones, tablets, or computers. The link for a particular race's ballot will not be activated until the Chair announces voting can begin. Members who use the

same email can access the same ballot link but must use their own unique Voter Code for their vote to be counted.

This virtual voting process may require you to have multiple windows open on your device so that you are able to cast your ballot while remaining logged in to the Zoom meeting. Due to the unavoidably cumbersome nature of this process, and the fact that many candidates are running unopposed, some races may be voted upon by acclamation rather than electronic ballot. If so, this will be announced during the meeting.

4. VOTER HELP DESK:

Any participant who has a ***ballot-related*** technical problem during a vote may call the volunteer help desk for assistance. The help desk number(s) will be announced at the beginning of the meeting and prior to each vote that is conducted by electronic ballot.

5. ELECTION RESULTS:

After each voting period, the results will be announced by the Chair and displayed on the Zoom screen.
